Most Frequently Used Codes

Placement

95249 - Initial personal CGM placement and training

95250 - Initial placement of professional CGM and training

*95249 and 95250 can be performed by multiple disciplines under the supervision of a Qualified Health Provider.

0446T - Initial implantable sensor placement and training

*Do not report 0446T in conjunction with 95251, 0447T, 0448T



Diabetes Self-Management Education & Support (DSMES)

G0108 - DSMES individual outpatient training services per 30 minutes.

G0109 - DSMES group outpatient session (two or more patients), per 30 minutes.

Interpretation of Data

95251 - Interpretation of CGM data. *Must be performed by a Qualified Health Provider unless state allows for a collaborative agreement.

Removal

0447T - Removal of sensor via incision

0448T - Removal of old sensor with new sensor insertion.

*Do not report 0448T in conjunction with 0446T, 0447T

Remote Patient Monitoring (RPM)

99091 - Collection and interpretation of remote data. 30 minutes of RPM clinical time between a patient and a physician per month, and also requires at least one instance of communication, which can be a call, video visit, or even email exchange.

*Cannot be billed in conjunction with 99457

99453 - Onboarding patient for RPM services

99454 - Monthly data transmission for patients receiving RPM services.

*Must be billed in conjunction with 99453

99457 - Initial treatment management of the patient for the first 20 minutes that clinical staff spends with a patient receiving RPM services.

*Follow-up to 99454 and 99453

*Maximum of 60 minutes per month billable in conjunction with 99458

99458 - Additional treatment management of patient receiving RPM services beyond the first 20 minutes.

*Maximum of 60 minutes per month billable in conjunction with 99457



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
