Biography: Steven E. Nissen, M.D., M.A.C.C.

Steven E. Nissen MD is Chief Academic Officer for the Heart, Vascular and Thoracic Institute at the Cleveland Clinic, the Lewis and Patricia Dickey Chair in Cardiovascular Medicine and Professor of Medicine at the Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine. From 2006 to 2019, he served as Chair of the Department of Cardiovascular Medicine at the Cleveland Clinic. In 2006-2007 he served as President of the American College of Cardiology (ACC).

In recent years, he has served as Study Chairman for large global cardiovascular outcomes trials, most studying lipid modifying therapies. His contributions to scientific literature include more than 600 journal articles and 60 book chapters. In 2007, *Time Magazine* selected Dr. Nissen as one of the world's 100 most influential people. Beginning in 2015, he was named by Thompson-Reuters as one of the world's most highly cited physician-scientists.
