Once I login to the app, why is it taking so long to sync to my account?

• The app continuously talks to your account on the IOL website. The first time you login, it may take a minute or two to sync all your profile data and course progress into the app.

• The evaluation and CE credit claim must be completed by August 18th.

How many CME/CE credits are available for the 85th Scientific Sessions?

• You can claim up to 29.5 CME/CE credits.

Why are my CME/CE credits not showing up?

• Ensure you have claimed your CME/CE after each session. Only claim COP (participation credit) if your professional credit is not available.

What should I do if the professional credit I need is not available, and only COP is available?

• Update your profession under your profile to claim the credits you need according to your profession. <u>Click here</u> for instructions on how to update your profession.

When will I receive my certificate?

• You can download your certificate after completing the overall evaluation. The system will total your credits as you claim them. The certificate will also be available in your account under the "My Transcript" tab on the left of your home screen.
